

What are your rights?

This policy tells you about privacy and personal information.

My Support collects information about you to help us to provide the right types of support.

You can choose:

- Yes or no to the type of information we collect, and
- When we are allowed to collect it







Personal information may include:

- Your name, address, phone number and email address
- Details about people who you are close to (parents, siblings or a good friend)
- Your Guardian or Advocate's details (if you have one)
- Supports you need or receive
- · Your medical records
- Other support providers you use
- How My Supports is helping you.

Security

My Supports makes sure that your information is kept safe and private.





You have rights about:

- · How, when, and why we use your personal information and
- · How we share and store this information.



You can:

- Ask My Supports to see your personal information at anytime
- Tell us if you think information
- Is wrong and needs to be fixed or removed.

My Supports will only share your information when:

- You agree
- You sign a consent form
- When the law, or someone's safety, requires us to.
